Children having money to pay for books will be permitted to take them home. Others may be ordered or reserved with the parent's permission.

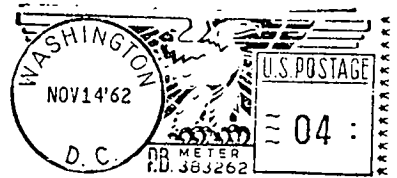
Temple Study Group
