In these remaining few weeks, take time to:

1. Review your notebook activities. Look back over them and consider all that you have learned about what it truly means to "become a Bar or Bat Mitzvah."
2. Consider attending the Bar/Bat Mitzvah services of the others in your cohort. Support them! Cheer them on! This is a simcha for our entire Jewish community!
3. All of your Hebrew should be learned, and you should be putting the final touches on your speech. If you haven't practiced on the bimah with your Tutor yet, using the Torah, make sure you do.
4. The meeting / rehearsal schedule is printed at the beginning of your notebook.

Meeting with Rabbi Schwartzman: Wednesday, three weeks before your Service.

First Rehearsal with Cantor and your partner:

Tuesday, two weeks before your service at 3 pm, for morning services.

Thursday, two weeks before your service at 3 pm, for afternoon services.

Final Rehearsal with Rabbi, your parents and your partner:

Tuesday, the week of your service at 4 pm for morning services.

Thursday, the week of your service at 4 pm for afternoon services.

Remember to show up 15 minutes before the start of Friday night's service. Meet in the lobby and bring your Friday Night packet!

Remember to show up 30 minutes before the start of Saturday's service. Meet in Rabbi Schwartzman's office: Bring all of your packets and your speech.
