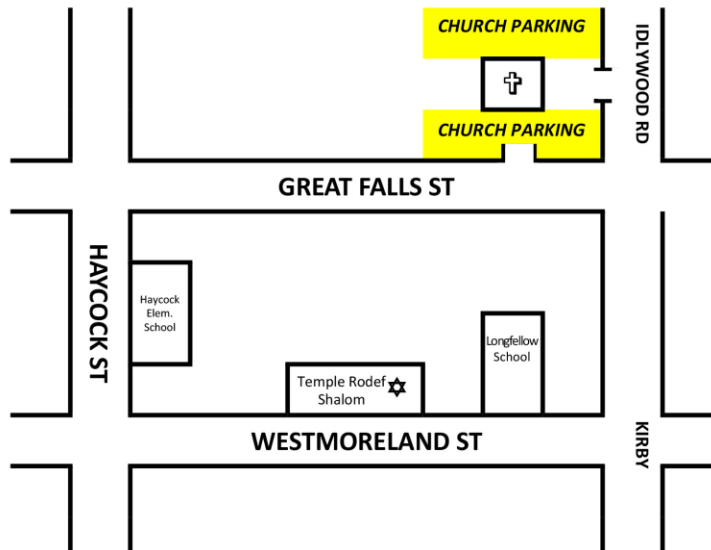


We're often asked about the High Holidays and how construction will impact us. The answer is: the services won't be impacted (there will be no construction on Rosh Hashanah or on Yom Kippur), but transportation and parking will be different this year. Every available space in the old lot will be reserved for those who have mobility issues. The 98 spaces in the new lot are available to all, first come, first served. In the sketch above, you'll see the traffic pattern. Please note that there is now an "Entrance Only" opening from Westmoreland (with a new speed bump!) and an "Exit Only" opening to Westmoreland. Drive carefully and keep an eye out for your fellow congregants, please! And, as always, please be a good neighbor if you park on the street, and please do NOT park on Kirby Court!

Of course, there are shuttles again, and we encourage you to use them, but the pick-up location is **DIFFERENT THIS YEAR**. The shuttles are **NOT** going to Chesterbrook Swim club OR St. Dunstan's Church. Don't park at those locations expecting to be picked up – it won't end well! Our **NEW** shuttle pick-up location is at the church at 2034 Great Falls Street, in Falls Church (on the corner of Great Falls and Kirby Road). It's a bit hidden, so you may wish to check it out before Erev Rosh Hashanah. See the map below.
