

Weekly Update 9/26/19



This week's update is about dirt, both adding and subtracting! In the picture above, you can see the entire foundation for the clergy/classroom addition and how there has been dirt filled in (known as backfilling) close to the foundation. We can now clearly see what will be "ground level" to the left of the addition. In fact, that is where the playground for our youngest Nursery School children will be (starting where the construction worker in yellow is standing in the picture).

As for the Small Sanctuary, the workers have been busy removing dirt. The foundation for the patio shows great progress, and we can start to see even more clearly the footprint of the Small Sanctuary and the foyer associated with it. Soon there will be visible progress on that foundation and the masonry work will begin.

A reminder as we all gather for Rosh Hashanah: as thrilling as it is to see the construction progress, make sure that you are looking at it through a window (or via these updates), NOT by going onto the site itself, even if the workers have left for the day. This is a safety issue – YOUR safety, which we greatly value!
