The construction progress continues to advance by leaps and bounds. The picture below is of a meeting room on the upper level of the clergy/classroom addition. You can see that one of the walls will be curved (!!)



The picture below shows how much of the exterior material has been installed. The light-colored material is EIFS, which stands for “Exterior Insulation and Finish System”. It’s a multi-layered exterior finish that is quite durable and rarely needs repainting as it is covered with a special coating. (I shared that fact with you two weeks ago, but a lot has happened in the world since then, so I thought you might have forgotten.) Look at all the windows that have been installed as well!



As for the Small Sanctuary addition, look at the lovely work that has been done in the foyer. The picture below was taken from the foyer as you enter the space through the vestibule, looking up. To your right is a small kitchen, a bathroom, and a space to be used by families when they have their lifecycle events in the Small Sanctuary.



We hope that this great work can continue, but we know that this can change at a moment's notice. We can only hope for the best, and we will keep you posted, of course.
