Reyna Pratt, Chair of the Building Project Task Force, provides our updates as construction progresses.

There isn't a part of our property that is untouched by construction right now, including our current sanctuary. We are using the expertise of our contractors to replace anything that needs it. This includes the HVAC system, the roof, the siding, the pavers and steps in front of our building, and the Sanctuary carpet. Our custodial staff moved all of the furniture out of the Sanctuary, the wings, the quiet room, even the closets. The carpet that was there had all sorts of stains, including from spilled coffee in the Sanctuary!! (That's not ok.)

And here are our senior clergy doing a socially (and physically) distanced "High Five" in front of the sanctuary, giving you another view of the removal work.
