

6.25.2020 Weekly Update

Reyna Pratt, Chair of the Building Project Task Force, provides our updates as construction progresses.

Today's update is about the Small Sanctuary addition, specifically the outside part. The exciting news for the week is that the Jerusalem stone (yes, shipped from Jerusalem!) is being installed on the outside of the structure. The picture below shows the front of the Small Sanctuary addition.



The cylindrical poles are at the entrance to the addition, and to the right you can see the overall look of the Jerusalem stone. There will also be Jerusalem stone installed on the outside of the covered corridor, which is to the left of the entrance.

Here is a closer view of the Jerusalem stone that has been installed:



Meanwhile, landscaping has begun on our new Oval (formerly the circle where there was clergy parking).

You might remember that everything looked bleak a little over a year ago.



There is still landscaping work to be done, but you can see the progress in the photo below:
