

Weekly Update 6.4.2020

Reyna Pratt, Chair of the Building Project Task Force, provides our updates as construction progresses.

Today's update is about the Multipurpose Room (which will likely have a new name – keep an eye out for that - but we'll call it the MPR for now). While the construction in the space is ongoing, there has been some marked progress. Let's take a tour!

In the picture below, the photographer had her back to the MPR. We can see the stairs going up to the top floor, and beyond them is the school lobby, which is currently full of building materials.



In the picture below, the photographer has turned around and is about to enter the MPR. You can see the metal structure for the ramp into the MPR. It will be covered with concrete soon. (We're so curious to know how that part of the construction process will work!) To the left of the ramp will be steps leading into the MPR.



The picture below is another view of the ramp, after the photographer had entered the MPR.



This final picture shows the progress that has been made in the MPR. The new folding panels have been installed and are tightly wrapped to protect them from damage during construction. (You can see the aqua-colored plastic with black tape across it – that plastic is protecting the panels.) As in the past, these panels can be pulled out to turn the space into two separate rooms or stored away to allow for one larger room. There will also be a new floor installed as well as audiovisual capabilities that will allow for watching streamed events or movies.
