

Weekly Update 10.1.2020

Reyna Pratt, Chair of the Building Project Task Force, provides our updates as construction progresses.

This week, I would like to highlight a new corridor that will eventually take us from the foyer outside of our Main Sanctuary into the foyer for the Small Sanctuary. This corridor runs parallel to the North Wing.

Currently, if you begin in the Main Sanctuary foyer and go to the right, this is your view.



You can see the doorway leading to the North Wing. The large white panel on the right of this picture will be removed in the coming weeks, and you'll be able to enter the corridor at that location. The steel that is above the white panel holds up that end of the building and will be framed by the entryway to the new corridor.

Here's a view of the corridor from the outside. Notice the lovely Jerusalem Stone and the abundance of windows.



Finally, here's a view from the end of the corridor.
