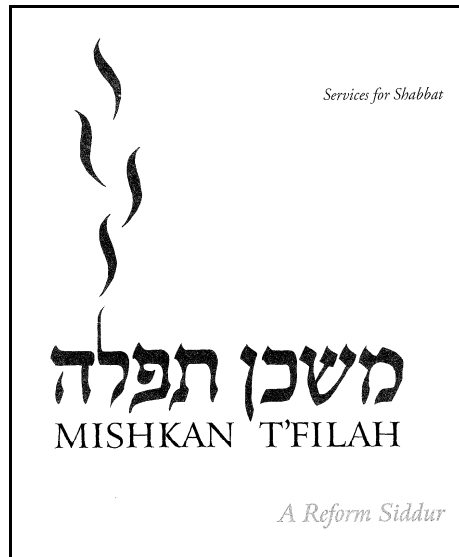

Blessing Before Reading of Torah

This is chanted before Aliyah 3

Tradition: Touch tallit to Torah text, then kiss tallit. Begin blessing:
