DEFIANT VOICES: A TEREZÍN MEDLEY showcases music that was performed by prisoners in the Theresienstadt Concentration Camp. The concert includes music by Beethoven and Bach, excerpts of famed Czech operas, jazz compositions from the camp's "Ghetto Swingers," as well as oratorio, cabaret, and folk music. The performance evokes the enduring story of cultural resistance through Murry Sidlin's signature blend of live performance, film clips, survivor testimony, and powerful narration to explore the musical and artistic life of the prisoners.

As the child of Holocaust survivors, Blitzer has worked tirelessly to promote Holocaust education and combat antisemitism throughout his career.
